Leonor Pinto is 33 years old. She is a mother of two and for several years now she was waiting for a new smile. She had several untreated cavities still at a very young age and after her first pregnancy she began to lose teeth, a situation that worsened with the second pregnancy. Nine years ago she put her first removable dental prosthesis, but the teeth that held it also fell and the prosthesis was no longer aligned. Eating was a difficult task for her and, as an educational assistant in a college where she works closely with children, she felt very ashamed of her teeth, which affected her psychologically, resulting in two depressions. Now, after the procedure that returned her oral health and smile, she says that she feels "much better" and that "everything has changed". She regained her self-esteem, and she no longer feels the need to hide her teeth and cover her mouth when she smiles.
